Workshop Choices

Open Exploration

This 2-hour program is our most open-ended option for students. Children have the opportunity to spend the full 2 hours engaging and exploring our exhibits.

This option does not include an educational workshop for children.

Grades: 3K-4th **Price:** \$6 per person

We Built This City*

We Built This City is an educational workshop that targets community helpers, three dimensional shapes, and basic architecture through large-scale building.

Grades: 4K-1st **Price:** \$8 per person

Busy Bees*

Busy Bees is an educational workshop that targets the wonderful world of honeybees. Students will engage in activities that teach about the life cycle, anatomy, and habits of our favorite pollinators.

Grades: 4K-2nd **Price:** \$8 per person

Operation Excavation*

Operation Excavation is an educational workshop that targets beginner archaeology. Students will engage in activities that open their eyes to the wonders beneath their feet.

Grades: 4K-2nd **Price:** \$8 per person

ARCHitecture*

ARCHitecture is an educational workshop designed to teach the structure and function of an arch. This incredible feat of engineering can be seen all over the world, and in our very own museum.

Grades: 2nd-4th **Price:** \$8 per person

The Mad Scientist*

The Mad Scientist is an educational workshop that gets young scientists fully engaged in a variety of wacky experiments that will both amaze them AND teach them something incredible.

Grades: K-4th **Price:** \$8 per person

Bone Detectives*

Bone Detectives is an educational workshop that enters the worlds of archaeology and paleontology. Students will learn how bones of all sorts are important discoveries, as well as reconstruct an animal skeleton.

Grades: 2nd-4th **Price:** \$8 per person
